Competencies:	<ol> <li>Collect data, record and assess a comprehensive health history, including social history.</li> <li>Perform and record extraoral and intraoral examinations and assessment of occlusion and hard tissue exam.</li> <li>Assess the need for, expose, develop, evaluate and interpret dental radiographs to include radiographic assessment of the periodontium and dentition.</li> <li>Expose and implement intraoral photography.</li> <li>Assess, plan, implement and evaluate a dental hygiene treatment plan.</li> <li>Formulate a dental hygiene diagnosis and supportive dental hygiene treatment plan.</li> <li>Assess the need for and perform initial and supportive periodontal therapies.</li> <li>Assess the need for and perform therapeutic hand and ultrasonic/sonic periodontal debridement therapies.</li> <li>Perform care and maintenance procedures for dental implants.</li> <li>Assess the need for and perform extrinsic stain removal procedures.</li> <li>Assess the need for and apply adjunctive topical chemotherapeutic and controlled released agents.</li> <li>Assess the need for and apply pain and anxiety management strategies.</li> <li>Assess the need for and plan professional topical fluoride and/or self-applied fluoride; apply professional fluoride.</li> <li>Apply principles of nutritional and/or tobacco cessation counseling to the management of oral health.</li> <li>Perform re-contouring and polishing of existing restorations.</li> <li>Take impressions for, pour and trim study models.</li> <li>Assess the need for and place pit and fissure sealants.</li> <li>Assess, plan and perform patient oral self-care education.</li> <li>Apply principles of ormprehensive record-keeping.</li> <li>Apply principles of comprehensive record-keeping.</li> <li>Apply principles of comprehensive record-keeping.</li> <li>Apply principles of evidence-based decision making.</li> <li>Demonstrate critical thinking and problem-solving skills when providing pat</li></ol>
